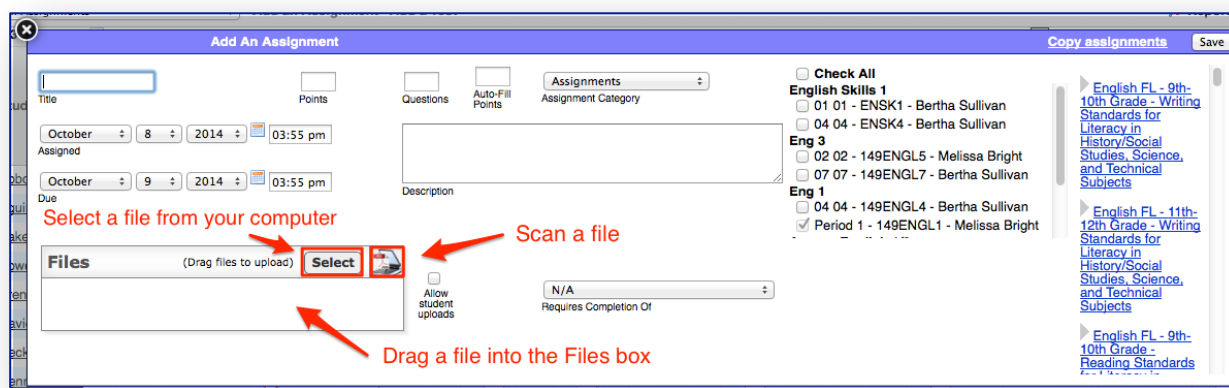

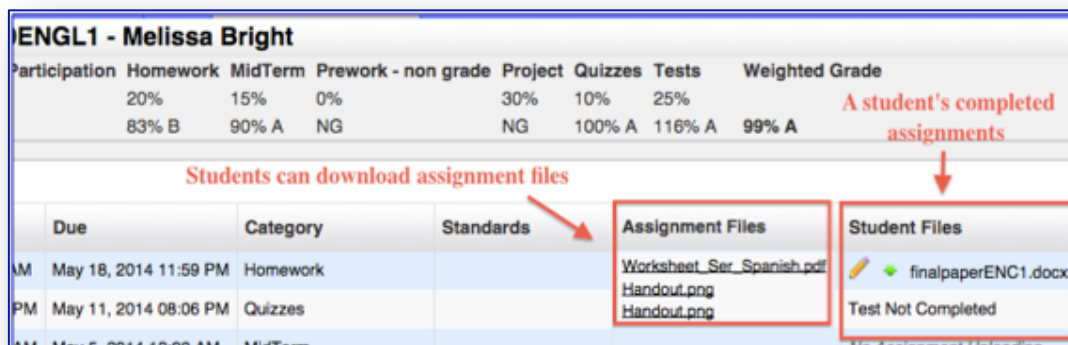
Scan and upload documents, conveniently attaching them to a Gradebook assignment

Teachers know that some assignments come with a little extra attached! With the LMS, attaching helpful directions, worksheets, and handouts is remarkably simple when new assignments are created. The “Drag and Drop” design lets teachers select a file from their computer and drag it into a file upload box, and the scan icon makes it fast to include hard copies into Focus. Don’t worry, there’s plenty of storage; attach as many files as you need! Students can download attachments when they access their assignments and grades.

With intuitive and powerful document management capabilities, Focus is every student’s new best friend. Completed assignments can be uploaded, edited, and stored with the teacher’s posted assignment, so there’s no wait to turning in completed work, and no risk of losing or forgetting any document throughout the year. When their assignment has been graded, students can download a copy that includes their teacher’s feedback at any time.

Uploaded student files are attached to Gradebook assignments, and already catalogued by date, class period, and student. Download them with the download icon, or simply use the *View/Annotate* icon to open, review, and score documents directly in the LMS. The LMS includes several annotating tools to provide feedback, including a number of comment boxes, colored highlights, and formatted text and draw options.

Parents stay connected with their own access to view assignments and teacher feedback

The LMS keeps parents in the loop with teachers and student performance. Parents can view their student's assignments, including the annotations, equipping parents a more complete view of the classroom.

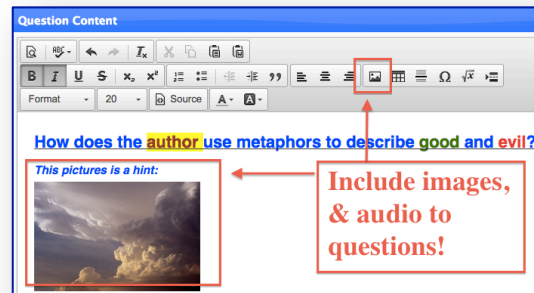
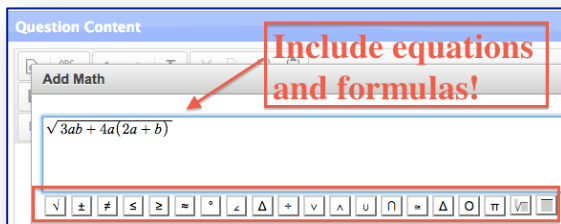

Tests are comprised of your own questions that feature a number of multimodal tools

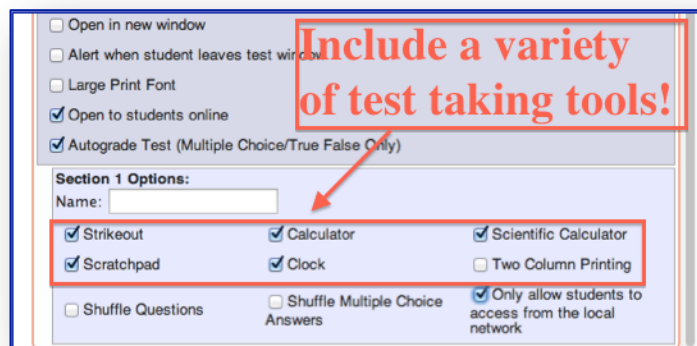
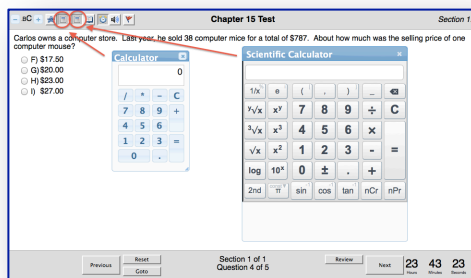
With Focus, teachers and administrators have the option to add a test in the same easy way that they add an assignment. Tests in the LMS contain user-made questions, which are easy to create with several question types and a variety of intuitive, yet powerful content tools: numerical and text editors, audio/video embedding, links to literary passages, and more.

These tests can be printed, and also taken directly in Focus where the scores sync automatically to the *Gradebook*. Tests can be assigned to the *Test History* feature in Focus, so the assessment tools can be used to track a student's progress.

When students take tests in Focus, there are a number of resources that teachers can activate, like scratch pads, calculators, and time clocks.

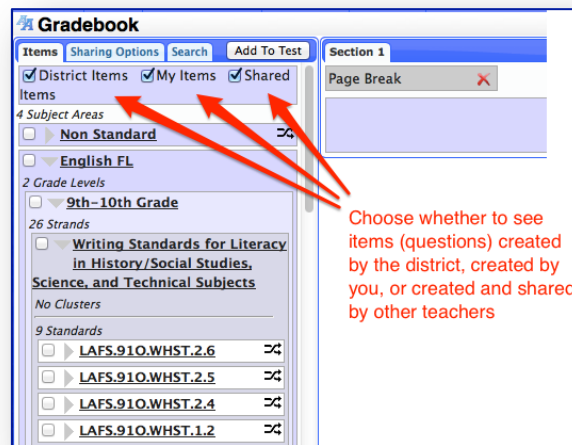

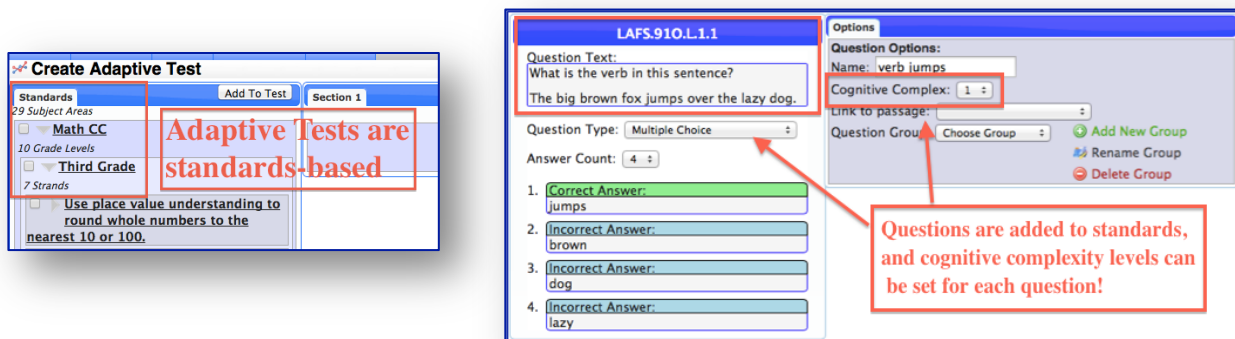
Stay connected and creative by sharing resources with other educators

Teachers and District-level administrators can share test questions, lessons, and activities with each other. The advantage with shared resources improves the work quality in the classroom, creation of standardized lessons, tests, and assessments across the District. Teachers will have access to a larger pool of test questions for faster test creation through the collaborative effort.



Create Adaptive Tests that are based on standards

In Focus, the *Adaptive Test* feature allows teachers and administrators to select standards to create tests. Their students can work through a test that has been arranged by cognitive complexity, only progressing to more difficult levels after the more simple questions of the preceding level are correctly answered.

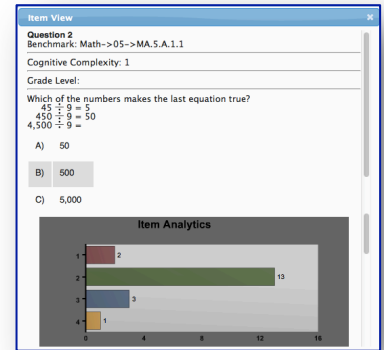

Stay on top of student performance analyses with LMS Reports

Focus provides several tools and reports for teachers and administrators to analyze student performance. Item analysis is available for individual test questions, and the *Standard Test Report*, *Adaptive Test Report*, and *Analyze Test* features provide an overview of student performance on tests. Teachers and administrators can also analyze student proficiency in specific standards.



Analyze overall student performance for every test question, and track their progression throughout the year.

The *Adaptive Test Report* provides a color-coded chart of students' results. Teachers can stay proactive with their lessons, as the diagnostic tool does not populate the *Gradebook*.

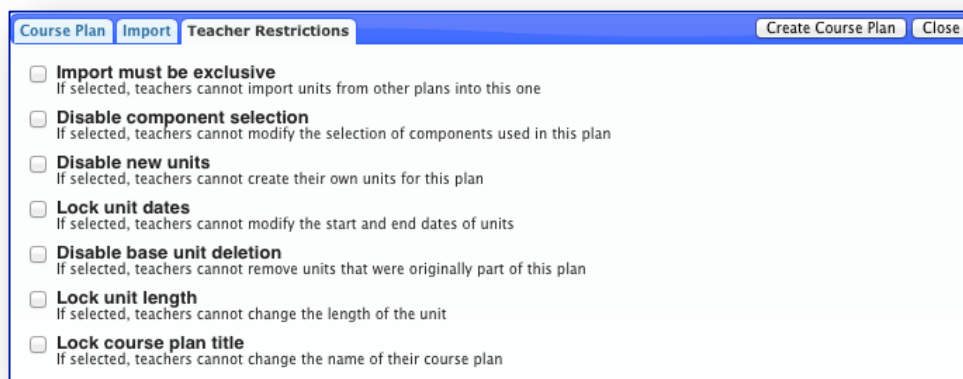
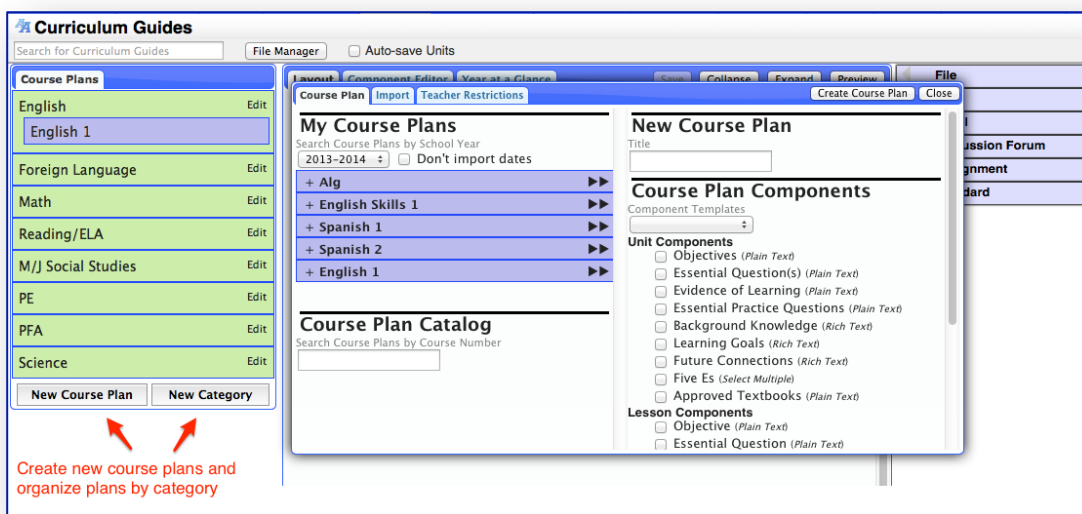

Keep every school up to speed with District-wide curriculum guides

Focus provides Districts with the ability to develop District-wide curriculum guides, which can be assigned to specific course numbers. Curriculum specialists can include unit and lesson components, files, links, assignments, and other lesson resources, along with specifying unit and lesson dates for pacing. Focus also includes the ability to set restrictions on what teachers can modify after importing the guide.

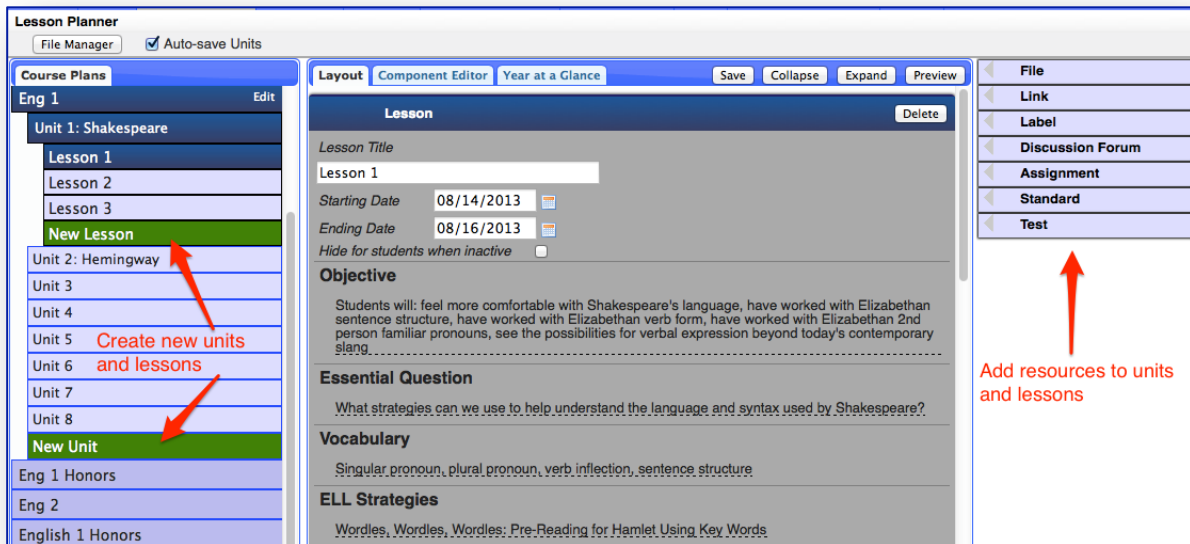


Create Course Plan

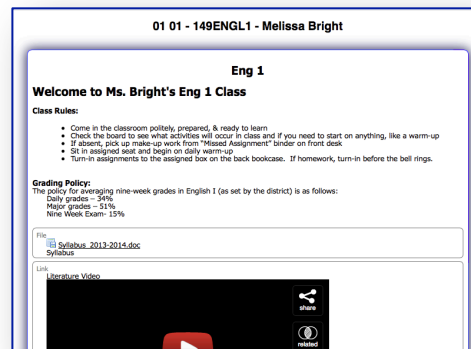
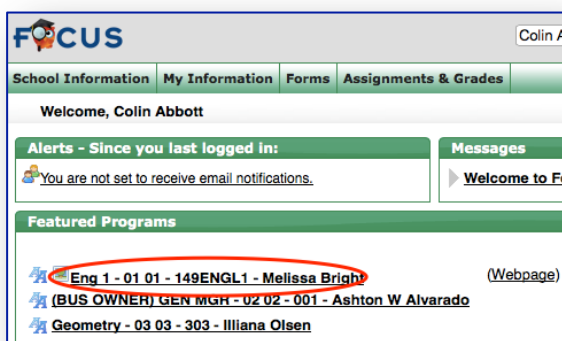
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to web content, embed videos, create discussion forums, link assignments and tests, and assign standards.

The *Course Web* page feature allows teachers to create web pages to convey important information to students within Focus. Web pages are a great way to include resources such as course syllabi, classroom rules and expectations, links to helpful websites, and important announcements. Students access the course web pages directly from the *Student Portal*.



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Review Teacher Lesson Plans

In Focus, administrators have quick access to both the curriculum guide catalog and teachers' lesson plans. School administrators can view lesson plans in a drill-down view, or in a .pdf format that can also be printed.
